Fresh Fruits and Vegetables Promote Health and Nutrition

From July through October this year, our Mobile Market was up and running after being on hold in 2020 due to COVID safety concerns. Thanks to the support of Beverly Hospital, a member of Beth



Israel Lahey Health and the Brace Cove Foundation, our clients were thrilled to see our return and the feeling was mutual. Beverly Bootstraps' Mobile Market is a free farmer's market that offers fresh fruits and vegetables to promote better health and nutrition to low-income households. This summer, residents of Apple Village and Turtle Woods/Creek Apartments enjoyed fresh produce delivered right to their neighborhood.

Tonya*, one of Food Pantry clients, has been taking full advantage of the fresh produce and trying new things. Recently she was able to pick up some locally grown squashes, zucchinis, and apples that were generously donated to us from a local farm. The next time she visited she excitedly told our staff that she had used this produce, along with staple items she picked up from our food pantry, to make a meal for 9 and a delicious batch of apple zucchini muffins.

The 2021 Mobile Market season distributed 11,763 pounds of produce and welcomed 1,364 shoppers. The overwhelming feeling from our clients is that they truly appreciated having access to all the fresh produce and enjoyed

trying new meals with what they received. Thanks to our donors, Tonya, and other families like hers, ate healthier this summer, expanded their palates, and alleviated some of the struggles of finding enough wholesome foods to eat.
