Beverly Bootstraps and our Food Assistance program are proud to announce that we were recently accepted as a non-profit partner of 1% for the Planet. 1% for the Planet helps build philanthropic relationships between



businesses and individuals and approved environmental nonprofits, creating high-impact partnerships that amplify the impact of member giving. As an organization, we are committed to doing our part to help the environment and more specifically, helping to create more sustainable food systems. Almost 40% of the food Beverly Bootstraps provides is rescued from local grocery stores, markets and farms helping to alleviate the environmental impacts of food waste. Did you know that food waste in landfills produces large amounts of methane – a more powerful greenhouse gas than even CO2, negatively impacting the environment?

We were honored to be invited to join this great cause and receive a generous donation to support our Food Assistance programs by our longtime partners, <u>Cell Signaling Technology (CST)</u>. CST recently signed on as the first company in the Life Science sector to make this pledge, committing 1% of their total yearly revenue to 1% for the Planet and nonprofit partners.
