Three months after her surgery, Monique's fridge and pantry were getting bare; even worse, she and her children were now facing eviction due to unpaid rent.

I'm sure you can imagine Monique's hopelessness as she described her situation to a Beverly Bootstraps Case Manager.

Through tear-filled eyes, Monique recounted her current situation. "I don't know what I'm going to do! We're already two months behind on rent and my landlord is threatening eviction. I've cut everything I can out of our budget, and even still, we often run out of food. Everything is so overwhelming right now! I can't bear to see my kids hungry any longer, let alone homeless."

I wish you could have heard the sigh of relief from Monique's mouth as she learned about all the services she could access.



Thanks to the support of generous individuals like you, Monique learned that she was eligible for rental and utility assistance, could visit the food pantry weekly, and could sign her kids up to receive free school supplies and holiday gifts.

Most importantly, the eviction process would be stopped, keeping Monique and her family safely housed in their home.
